New Job Training Program Culinary Arts

This new job training program includes hands-on kitchen training, job coaching, guest speakers from the culinary world, field trips, career readiness training and job search support. All training at SCC is free, and participants who continue to BHCC may be eligible for scholarships and Pell Grants to cover tuition and fees.

Who should apply?

This program is open to anyone who wants to build a career as a cook or in the culinary world. Priority is given to Somerville residents. No education or work experience requirements.

Participants who continue to the BHCC courses need to have a high school diploma or equivalent, authorization to work in the United States, and a proficient level of English.
